





What is personalised education?




An **educator** makes lessons and activities on what you want to learn about.


An educator is a teacher.

No one can make you go.




You can change your mind at any time about if you want to go.

What is relationships and sexuality education?




Relationships and sexuality education is when you learn about safe and healthy **relationships**, **sexuality** and good **sexual health**.




Relationships are the connections we have with other people.

Sexuality is who you feel attracted to and how you feel about yourself




Sexual Health is part of your overall health.

Everybody has sexual health whether they have sexual activity or not.




Relationships and sexuality education is sometimes called RSE.

An educator can help you


- understand relationships


What can I learn about in RSE?



- **Sexual Consent**



Sexual consent is permission for sexual touch to happen. Giving consent means you want to do sexual touch, not giving consent means you do not want to do sexual touch. For sexual touch to happen, both people need to give consent.

What do sessions look like?




Your session will be at SHFPACT.

You will tell reception that you are here for an education session.




The sessions will be in a private room with you and the educator.

These questions will help you learn new things.




In the session you can

Who can the educator talk to about our sessions?




You can choose if the educator talks to other people about your sessions.



You could ask them to tell your


- partner

Sometimes a counsellor will need to tell someone else about your sessions.

They will have to tell someone

- if you are hurt by someone who should take care of you
- if they think you could hurt yourself
- if they think you might hurt someone else



This is called **mandatory reporting**.

Mandatory reporting is the law.



The counsellor will tell someone who can help keep everyone safe because it is their job.

The sessions are \$193.99 for one hour.



Hard words list

An **educator** is a teacher.

Mandatory reporting is a law that says certain professionals must report concerns about neglect, abuse, or dangerous behaviours.

Relationships are about the connections we have with other people that we spend time with, talk to, and do things with. Like your friends, family, partner, classmates, colleagues, bosses, neighbours, and team mates.

Sexual Consent is permission for sexual touch to happen. Giving consent means you want to do sexual touch, Not giving consent means you do not want to do sexual touch. For sexual touch to happen, both people need to give consent.

Sexual health is a part of your overall health. Sexual health includes your relationship to yourself and others, sexual health checks and having safer sexual activities. Everybody has sexual health whether they have sexual activity or not.

Sexuality is who you feel attracted to and how you feel about yourself. It is not just about who you have sex with or want to have sex with. It's about self-expression, fantasies, desires, relationships, and more.
